# STANDING IN SOLIDARITY

In 1999, Solidarity Bridge began as a medical mission organization providing surgery for impoverished Bolivian patients. It soon became clear that much more was needed to make a lasting difference including training, equipment and a year-round local presence. Puente de Solidaridad (PuenteSol) was formed in 2005 and facilitates efforts full-time from bases in Cochabamba and Santa Cruz.

Today, Solidarity Bridge provides advanced surgical training, equipment and supplies to support permanent programs in General Surgery, Gynecologic Surgery, Heart Surgery and Neurosurgery. Approximately six mission trips each year enhance programs by progressively upgrading local skills, stimulating new strategies and partnerships and directly serving the most critical patients.

# Fighting Chagas with Doctors Without Borders

The small village of Aiquile, five hours from Cochabamba via cobblestone road, is the Bolivian epicenter of Chagas, a parasitic disease that slowly gains strength and ultimately ravages hearts and other organs. Chagas is a major health challenge in Latin America. In Aiquile, three out of four people are infected with it.

Since 2011, Solidarity Bridge has partnered with Doctors Without Borders (MSF) to confront Chagas here. MSF provides early detection and treatment; we provide pacemakers and megacolon surgery for patients with advanced disease. # A Year of Expanded Partnerships and Surgical Complexity

Our 2013 mission trip was crucial to program growth. A new local partner received training in laparoscopic gall bladder and hernia surgery. Existing partners were revisited and continued to upgrade their capacities to manage highly complex megacolon and oncological surgery patients. More than 20 Bolivian doctors, nurses, and residents observed and participated in the hands-on training.



During each of Dr. Malcolm Bilimoria's five mission trips, he has trained select Bolivian surgeons to take on pancreatic and other oncology cases that until recently were considered inoperable in Bolivia. In the US, Dr. Bilimoria directs the Center for Pancreatic and Hepatobiliary Diseases at Northwest Community Hospital in Arlington Heights, IL.

# TEOFILIA'S STORY

Teofilia suffered for years with back, neck and stomach pain. Laparoscopic gall bladder surgery changed her life. When Teofilia woke and realized her pain was gone, she cried with joy. After just one night in the hospital, she was ready to go home, saying over and over, "Gracias! Gracias! Gracias!"

Teofilia's team included Dr. Gay Garrett, general surgeon; Dr. Gabe Pitta, anesthesiologist and Dr. Luis Herrera, our newest general surgery program partner who provided Teofilia's follow-up care. In 2013, Dr. Herrera implemented techniques honed alongside Dr. Garrett to perform 19 gall bladder and hernia surgeries.

## **Defibrillator Training Addresses Growing Need**

Solidarity Bridge held its first training mission on defibrillators (ICDs) and biventricular defibrillators (CRT-Ds). These implants are in high demand for advanced Chagas patients, but procedures have been limited due to the

high cost of implants and scarcity of surgeons able to perform the specialty surgeries.

Dr. Khouzam is an electrophysiologist at Dayton Heart Center, Ohio. He worked with seven Bolivian surgeons to perform 11 cardiac implants and presented two conferences to 34 physicians.

# **Generosity in Action: Medtronic**

# SOLIDARITY VISIT

In the Spring of 2013, Bolivian neurosurgeons, Dr. Karin Aponte and Dr. Juan Antonio Moreno, made a five-week "Solidarity Visit" to the US. They observed world class neurosurgeons at Lurie Children's Hospital, Central Dupage Hospital, Stroger Cook County Hospital and Mt. Sinai Hospital in Chicago and the University of Massachusetts Medical Center, Boston, and attended the 2013 American Association of Neurological Surgeons (AANS) conference in New Orleans. Thank you, Drs. Art DiPatri, Roberta Glick, and Richard Moser, for your leadership throughout their stay.

## **New Techniques and Tools Advance Neurosurgery**

In January 2013, our US and Bolivian teams performed transnasal endoscopic pituitary tumor surgeries in Cochabamba and Santa Cruz. Both mission trips included training in minimally invasive spinal surgery techniques and presentations on adult and pediatric neurosurgery. Solidarity Bridge also initiated conversations to establish a Bolivian Institute for the Development of Neurosurgery, a collaborative effort that continues in 2014.

# GYNECOLOGIC SURGERY PROGRAM

Thank you to Hologic for the permanent loan of NovaSure equipment valued at \$20,000 and the donation of disposable procedure kits. Dr. Janet Tomezsko, urogynecologist, NorthShore University Health System, Evanston, IL, has taught and performed thousands of bladdersling surgeries in her 16 years of practice. In 2013, she taught Bolivian physicians the TVT technique, expanding their treatment options for stress incontinence, a common condition among Bolivian women.

In 2013, Solidarity Bridge introduced a new technique to treat a debilitating condition that plagues many Bolivian women. The 90-second NovaSure endometrial ablation procedure stops heavy bleeding, often eliminating the need for a hysterectomy. Patients can return to their activities the next day, making treatment possible for women unable to take time off from work or be away from their families while recovering.

Magued Khouzam, Carrie Giordano, Bob LaPata, Ricardo Palop and Dan Yousif worked closely with the Yungas Hospital surgical staff all week. **On this fifth mission trip to Coroico** more than 1,200 patients were treated by specialists in pediatrics, internal medicine, dermatology, cardiology and gynecology. Missioners and Bolivian medical staff worked together in clinics and two surgery suites.

When mudslides closed the new highway, the Solidarity Bridge team had to travel the "old road," gaining a deep appreciation for the challenging conditions Bolivians face each day.
