


A word from the Executive Director

Patient Profile



Magali is a delicate 13 yr old with a deficient mitral heart valve. When Magali was four she caught rheumatic fever. She was sick for many months but her parents thought it was just a bad cold. For years she continued to be weak. Magali's father is a farm worker and her mother cares for their domestic animals which give a little more sustenance for the family. Magali's parents simply didn't have the money so they put off bringing her to a doctor.

Eventually, Magali didn't even have the strength to walk and her family saw the gravity of the situation. They sent Magali to her sister, Nancy, who lives in the city and could take her to the hospital. The doctors told them the devastating news that the only thing that could help Magali was open heart surgery. In Bolivia, this surgery costs over \$15,000 - an inconceivable sum for a family that makes \$3.50 a day. Nancy explained "At that moment we felt that there was nothing to do – only to leave her to die. Even if we sold everything we had, we could not pay for her surgery. When I told my father that Magali would die without surgery, I was afraid that the news would kill him too."

Fortunately, the hospital contacted Solidarity Bridge and we took on Magali's case. In December, through the generosity of the Goff Gift Fund, our doctors quite literally held Magali's heart in their hands and saved her life. Magali is recovering and this beautiful child can now look forward to a full life of possibility.


